2007 Summer Youth Camps



Eagle Bluff is offering three types of camps in 2007. All camps will feature a variety of fun activities that may include: canoeing, rock climbing, an overnight campout, and the Tree Tops high ropes course! Day camps will meet for five days from 8:30am-3:30pm. The residential camps run for three or five nights, with check-in beginning at 6:30pm on the first day. Our excursion camps spend one night camping at Eagle Bluff and two nights camping offsite. Registration for the excursion camp begins at 1:30pm. Both the residential and excursion camps conclude with a dinner for the whole family at 6pm in the dining hall. The cost of each camp includes: food, lodging, all activities, and a specially designed 2007 summer camp T-shirt! A list of what to bring to camp will be included in the confirmation packet.

<p>Exploring: The Root River June 25-29 Cost: \$115 Students Entering Grades 4 & 5</p> <p>The Root River is full of history, amazing critters, and opportunities for recreational activities. In this day camp, we will explore all that the Root River has to offer.</p>	<p>Water Adventure Camp Sun. July 8- Wed. July 11 Cost: \$230 Ages 10-12</p> <p>Get your feet wet with a field trip sampler highlighting the unique Root River Valley. This area of Minnesota is known specifically for its fishing, canoeing, and caving opportunities. Let the adventures begin!</p>	<p>State Park Excursion: Whitewater State Park Sun. June 17-Wed. June 20 Cost: \$230 Ages 13-15</p> <p>Minnesota has a fantastic State Park system and this excursion will let campers experience Whitewater State Park in a whole new way! A short hike into the Park will bring campers to their campsite. Activities will take place throughout the Park and will introduce campers to the basics of backpacking.</p>
<p>Exploring: Outdoor Adventures June 25-29 Cost: \$115 Students Entering Grades 6 & 7</p> <p>Life is supposed to be fun, so why not learn some lifetime outdoor skills? This day camp offers campers the chance to enjoy competitive orienteering, rock climbing, river canoeing, and archery...to just name a few!</p>	<p>Forkhorn Camp Sun. July 15- Fri. July 20 Cost: \$355 Ages 12-14</p> <p>The Minnesota Deer Hunters Association sponsors this camp for youth interested in deer hunting. Campers will learn to perfect a buck grunt, track deer, choose the right tree for their stand, and test their aim at our gun and archery ranges. <i>(We highly encourage Forkhorn campers to have their Firearms Safety Certificate before camp. Those that do not have the certification will be able to complete the course and take the test during camp.)</i></p>	<p>Paddlers Sun. July 22- Wed. July 25 Cost: \$230 Ages 13-15</p> <p>Want to spend a few days canoeing, but don't feel you are quite ready for two weeks in the Boundary Waters? This is the perfect camp for you! Campers will spend three days canoeing approximately 30 miles down the Root River while learning the basics of canoeing, camping out, and extended outdoor trips.</p> <p><i>Our excursion camps are meant to be an introduction to more intensive outdoor activities. Due to the physical, extended nature of these trips, campers should be in relatively good physical condition.</i></p>
<p>The Quest! July 30- August 3 Cost: \$115 Students Entering Grades 6 & 7</p> <p>The Quest! is a scavenger hunt like none other! Campers will spend the week searching for clues, learning new skills to accomplish tasks, and having a blast while doing so. This day camp also includes an optional overnight campout on Thursday night.</p>	<p>Night Camp Sun. July 22- Wed. July 25 Cost: \$230 Ages 11-13</p> <p>New this summer, Night Camp will give campers the chance to experience Eagle Bluff after the sun goes down. Each night campers will stay up later than the previous night and by the last night, campers will watch the sun rise before heading off to bed. Rest assured that campers will still have at least eight hours of sleep each day!</p>
