

Dream Catchers



Kit Materials:

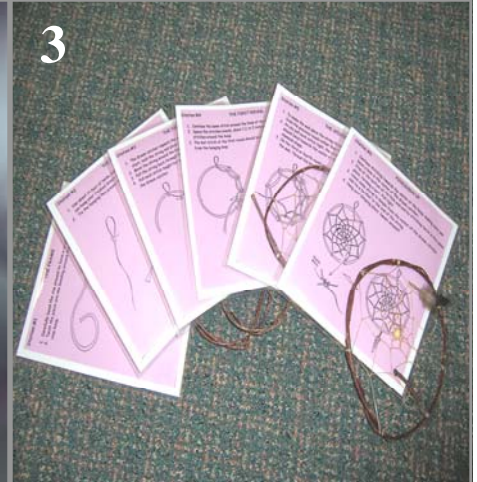
- Lesson Plan
 - Sample Dream Catcher in case
 - Instructions with examples in folder
 - Sinew (2 spools)
 - Beads in container
 - Feathers in container
 - Red rope for demo
- Not in Kit:**
- Hula-hoop for demo



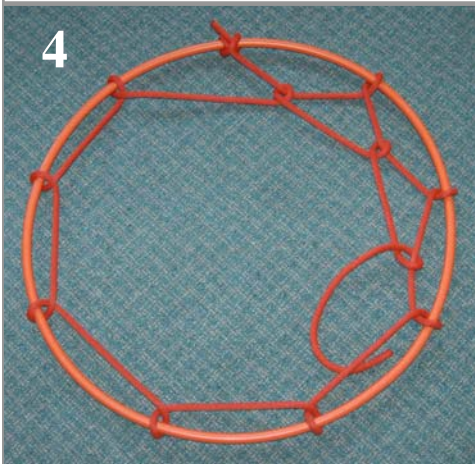
1 Ask the students to share some of their dreams with the group.



2 Read aloud to the class "The Origin of the Dream Catcher" from the lesson plan.



3 Share with the class the "Instruction Cards" with examples.



4 If necessary demonstrate how to weave a dream catcher with the Hula-hoop and rope.



5 Let the students pick one bead, one feather, and one willow branch.



6 Instruct each student to cut five to ten feet of sinew depending on how intricate a web they would like to weave. The more intricate the web, the more sinew.



7 Be available to help students with cutting sinew, making hoops from willow branches, and tying knots.



8 If there is time available ask the students to show and tell their dream catcher with the rest of the group.



9 Have the students help clean up; place listed equipment in the tub and extra willows branches in the bucket.
