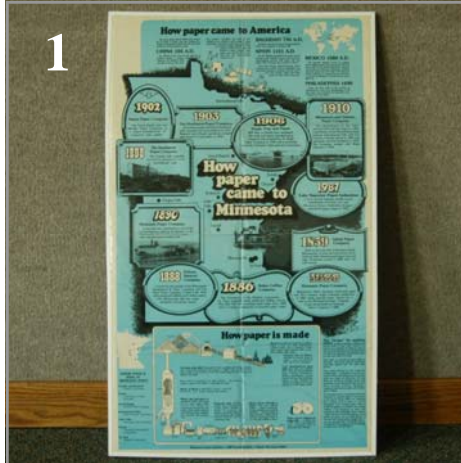

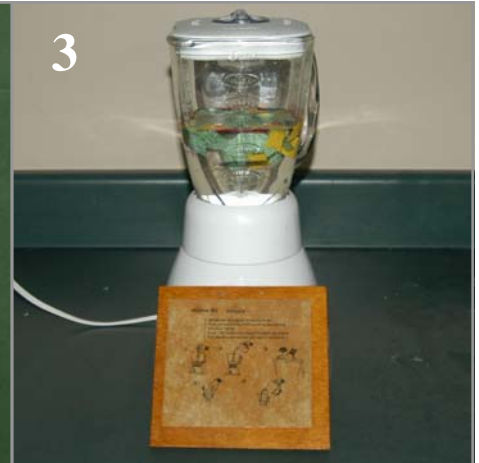
EVENING ACTIVITY QUICK REFERENCE GUIDE



1 Use the posters to summarize the history of paper. Demonstrate how to make paper by moving through the stations.



2 Station 1: Tear paper into 1/2" pieces and place on tray. Tear just enough paper to fill the blender to the black line.



3 Station 2: Fill blender to the black line with paper pieces and add water up to the red line; blend.



4 Stations 3 & 4: Pour the mixture evenly into the deckle. Use the felt to dry your paper as much as possible.



5 Station 5: With the felt piece inside, slam the deckle upside down onto a tray knocking the new paper onto the felt.



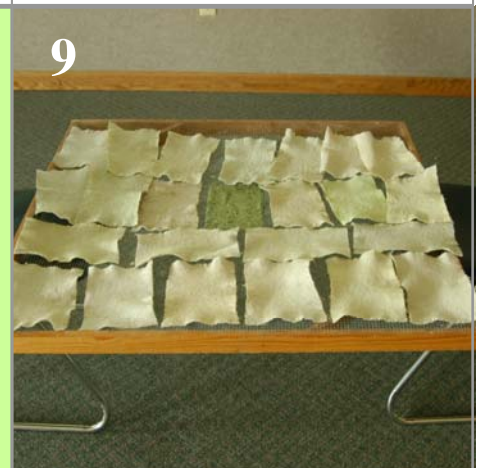
6 Station 6: Use the felt to carry the new paper to the drying racks. Flip them paper side down and peel off the felt.



7 While the students are making paper monitor the use of the blender and offer assistance as needed.



8 At the end ask the students what other resources besides paper can be recycled. What are the benefits to recycling?



9 Wash out the blenders and spread the felt out so it can dry. Put everything that can be dried into the tubs.
