

# WHAT TO BRING CHECKLIST

Students and adults are responsible for bringing personal items and clothing that are appropriate for the season. We want your stay at Eagle Bluff ELC to be pleasant and enjoyable. Reminder: Eagle Bluff ELC is not responsible for personal property lost, stolen or damaged during your visit. Please have students label luggage and personal items with their name and school's name.

When packing, students and adults should put important outdoor wear such as rain gear, boots, hats and coats in a place that will be easily accessible upon arrival. Groups are unable to check into their dorm rooms until 4:15 p.m., but will be attending their first class at 1:15 p.m. Quick access to outdoor necessities will be important.

Please note that there will be a postage fee for any items left at Eagle Bluff that need to be mailed back to the school or individual. The fee will equal the cost of the postage necessary to mail the item(s).
